WHAT DOES IT MEAN TO BE ON A LIBRARY BOARD?

Library Board members serve a four-year term and are responsible for the governance of the Elyria Public Library system. Attendance at monthly meetings is expected.

Responsibilities undertaken by the board include:

- Overseeing a Director and Chief Financial Officer.
- Identifying and representing local community needs and interests.
- Participating in essential planning.
- Overseeing finances.
- Determining policies to govern library operations.
- Promoting and advocating for the library.
