### Vice President/Membership Report – Kathy Burrer

Kathy Burrer reported that, at this time, we have 29 yearly members; 5 corporate members; and 20 lifetime members; for a total of 54 members.

#### <u>Treasurer's Report – Patti Baker</u>

Iris Tewksbury reported for Patti Baker in her absence. As of last month's reconciliation, we had \$31,454.73. Since that time, we paid the LaGrange Municipal Village our quarterly payment (for use of the sorting and storage rooms) which leaves us at \$31,304.74.

Iris and Wendi had discussed how the Friends can make their funds work for them. They checked rates for certificates of deposit (CD) from three financial institutions. They shared the interest rates and monthly investment time with the Friends this evening. Discussion followed. The Friends agreed that they should address the size of the budget first; then, the rest could go into the CD. Kathy Burrer made a motion that the Friends put \$20,000 in a 14-month CD at a 5% interest rate with Huntington Bank. Rose Fiscaletti seconded the motion. Vote on the Motion: Unanimous Approval.
