Vice President/Membership Report – Kathy Burrer

Kathy Burrer reported that we received an application and dues from a new member this evening (Debby Krejsa). We now have 34 yearly members.

<u> Treasurer Report – Marcia DeJonge</u>

Marcia DeJonge shared with the Friends transactions that occurred since her last report. There were no deposits this time around. Expenses included our quarterly rental fee in the amount of \$150.00 and advertising in the amount of \$148.00. Our balance at this time is \$7,198.87.

Wendi Zwaduk informed the Friends that the LaGrange Village Municipal Building asked if the Friends could increase their rental amount to \$75.00 a month (currently \$50.00) due to the Village's increase in the cost of electricity. The rental increase will start in January 2025, and the Friends will still be able to pay the rent quarterly.. Kathy Burrer made a motion that the Friends accept the increase in rent beginning January 2025. Discussion followed on the free use of the
