Adams, Ellery *Paper Cuts*-cozy mystery- (Book 6 in the Secret, Book & Scone Society) Nora Pennington helps her bookstore customers find healing through the perfect book—while solving the town’s real-life murders with the help of her Secret, Book, and Scone Society members.

Adjei-Brenyah, Nana Kwame *Chain-Gang All-Stars* -Two top women gladiators fight for their freedom within a depraved private prison system not so far-removed from America’s own.

Allen, Jayne *Black Girls Must Have It All* –(Book 3 in the Black Girls Must Die Exhausted Series) Tabitha is juggling work, relationships, and a newborn baby—but will she find the happy ending she’s always wanted?

Aquino, Melissa Coss *Carmen and Grace* -An emotionally riveting coming-of-age drama about two cousins lured into the underground drug trade at a young age and the inextricable ties that bind them, as one woman seeks power, and the other seeks a way out.

Baldacci, David *Simply Lies*-mystery- Hardened ex-cop Mickey Gibson must play cat and mouse head-to-head with a woman with sociopathic tendencies who has no name and a mysterious past.

Beanland, Rachel *The House Is on Fire* -mystery- A masterful work of historical fiction about an incendiary tragedy that shocked a young nation and tore apart a community in a single night—told from the perspectives of four people whose actions during the inferno changed the course of history.

Bentley, Don *Forgotten War* – (Book 4 in the Matt Drake Series) A brotherhood born in battle is endangered by a deadly secret.

Black, Maggie *Cold Case Chase* -romance- Sergeant Anthony Jones never expected the most challenging fugitive he’d ever have to track down would be his childhood sweetheart, Tessa Watson.

Bose, Disha *Dirty Laundry* -mystery- A twisty, domestic suspense debut about a clique of mothers that shatters when one of their own is murdered, bringing chaos to their curated lives.

Brashears, Monica *House of Cotton* - Magnolia Brown is nineteen years old, broke, and effectively an orphan. Cotton walks in and offers to turn Magnolia’s luck around, but she soon discovers there’s more at stake than her rent.

Brennan, Allison *Seven Girls Gone* -mystery- (Book 4 in the Quinn & Costa Thrillers) When women end up missing, and then dead, Police Detective Beau Hebert calls in a favor from the FBI’s Mobil Response team who send in Kara Quinn and Matt Costa to officially investigate.

Bunn, T. Davis *Shell Beach* –(Book 8 in the Miramar Bay Series) Noah is leaving a life he’s spent 12 years building. Jenna is an end-of-life nurse. They are brought together in the most unexpected way to navigate their future.

Cameron, Marc *Breakneck* –(Book 5 in the Arliss Cutter Series) A train ride into the Alaskan wilderness turns into a harrowing fight for survival for Deputy US Marshall Arliss Cutter, and a mother and daughter marked for death.

Castro, V. *The Haunting of Alejandra* -horror- A woman is haunted by the Mexican folk demon La Llorona as she unravels the dark secrets of her family history in this ravishing and provocative horror novel.

Chadwick, Elizabeth *The King's Jewel* – Wales, 1093, and Nesta must decide between duty and desire as she tries to survive in a man's world where everyone who should protect her is either dead or banished.

Chong, Kevin *The Double Life of Benson Yu* -This fresh and unique work of metafiction follows a graphic novelist losing control of his own narrative as he attempts to write a polished retelling of his fraught upbringing in 1980s Chinatown.

Clark, Mary Higgins *Where Are the Children Now?* -mystery- (Book 2 in the Where Are the Children Series) The children of Nancy Harmon are all grown up and in peril again.

Claycomb, Ann *Silenced*-fantasy- Four women. Four enchantments. One man. But he is no handsome prince, and this is no sugar-sweet fairy tale.

Clipston, Amy *Breaking New Ground*- (Book 3 in the Amish Legacy Series) Korey Bontrager and Savannah Zook are just pretending to date—but could their feelings turn into something more?

Connolly, Rebecca *Under the Cover of Mercy* - Can one nurse on a mission of mercy and rebellion turn the tide of WWI?

Dallas, Sandra *Where Coyotes Howl* - Except for the way they loved each other, they were just ordinary, everyday folks. Just ordinary.

Deese, Nicole *The Words We Lost* – (A Book in the Fog Harbor Romance Series) When Ingrid's best friend passes away, she finds herself on a quest with Cece's cousin Joel to recover a package – and perhaps recover herself.

Deveraux, Jude *My Heart Will Find You* -romance – While locked down during the pandemic, Etta begins to dream of a man from the 1870s whose story inspired the dreams. Now she is beginning to wonder if he is actually out there.

Doctorow, Cory *Red Team Blues* -A hard-charging, hard-fighting techno-thriller detective story about a forensic accountant, Marty, who is coming out of retirement for one last job.

Eddings, Mazey *The Plus One* -romance- What starts out as a fake wedding date turns into something these childhood enemies never expected.

Elliott, Kate *Furious Heaven* -science fiction- (Book 2 in the Sun Chronicles Series) Non-stop action, space battles and intrigue abound in the second galactic-scale, gender-swapped space opera trilogy inspired by the life of Alexander the Great.

Escobar, Mario *The Swiss Nurse* - Based on the true story of an astonishingly brave woman who saved hundreds of mothers and their children during the Spanish Civil War and World War II.

Estleman, Loren D. *City Walls* – mystery – (Book 31 in the Amos Walker Series) The search for a fugitive embezzler leads Amos Walker to Cleveland, where he is hired by Emmett Yale, a leading figure in the electric car industry, to investigate the murder of his stepson.

Frazier, Charles *The Trackers* - A stunning new novel that paints a vivid portrait of life in the Great Depression.

Gabriel, Maan *Twelve Hours in Manhattan* – romance –Twelve magical hours spent away from their respective lives make Bianca wonder if she can return to her regular life with only her memories to sustain her.

Gilmore, Lucy *The Lonely Hearts Book Club* -A young librarian and an old curmudgeon forge the unlikelyst of friendships in this charming novel about one misfit book club and the lives it changed along the way.

Graham, Heather *Shadow of Death* -romance - When two hikers go missing within a series of daunting caves outside of Denver, Colorado, FDLE special agent Amy Larson and her partner, FBI special agent Hunter Forrest, have good reason to suspect foul play.

Graves, Sarah *Death by Chocolate Marshmallow Pie* – cozy mystery- (Book 6 in the Death by Chocolate Series) Chocolate-themed recipes, appealing characters, and an unpredictable mystery make the perfect mix.

Gray, Anissa *Life and Other Love Songs* - A father's sudden disappearance exposes the private fears, dreams, longings, and joys of a Black American family in the late decades of the twentieth century.

Griffiths, Elly *The Last Remains* -mystery – (Book 15 in the Dr Ruth Galloway Mystery Series) The discovery of a missing woman's bones force Ruth and Nelson to finally confront their feelings for each other as they desperately work to exonerate one of their own.

Hannon, Irene *Windswept Way* – (Book 9 in the Hope Harbor Series) Buying a haunted house was never in Ashley Scott's plans, but when an intriguing opportunity drops into her lap after a major setback, she finds herself trekking cross-country to Hope Harbor on the Oregon coast to launch a new life.

Hansen, Valerie *Scent of Truth* – (Book 2 in the Pacific Northwest K-9 Series) An innocent suspect. A look-alike killer. Can a K-9 team crack this case?

Harris, C. S. *Who Cries for the Lost* -mystery – (Book 18 in the Sebastian St. Cyr Mystery Series) A gripping new historical mystery featuring Sebastian St. Cyr.

Henry, Emily *Happy Place* -romance- A couple who broke up months ago pretend to still be together for their annual weeklong vacation with their best friends.

Hillerman, Anne *The Way of the Bear* -mystery- (Book 8 in the Leaphorn, Chee and Manuelito Series) An unexpected death on a lonely road outside of Utah's Bears Ears National Park raises questions for Navajo Tribal Police officers Jim Chee and Bernadette Manuelito.

Hood, Joshua *Robert Ludlum's the Treadstone Rendition* –(Book 4 in the Treadstone Series) The final days of the American presence in Afghanistan bring Adam Hayes a summons he can't ignore in the latest electrifying thriller.

Jackson, Joshilyn *With My Little Eye* -mystery- the hair-raising story of a mother who moves herself and her daughter across the country to lose a dangerous stalker—only to discover that it will take more than distance to escape him.

Jimenez, Abby *Yours Truly*-romance- (Book 2 in the Part of Your World Series) A novel of terrible first impressions, hilarious second chances, and the joy in finding your perfect match.

Johns, Patricia *Their Amish Secret* – (Book 2 in the Amish Country Matches Series) Claire never told Joel she'd had his child. But he's been searching for them since he learned about their son.

Johnson, Wayne *The Witch Tree* – (Book 2 in the Buck Fineday Series) Buck, aka Michael Fineday, aka Red Deer is on his way to track down his wayward brother in the Twin Cities, when he's trapped in a snowstorm and rescued by Sally, a girl who is fighting her own demons.

Kang, Han *Greek Lessons* – An unlikely bond between a woman losing her voice and a man losing his vision.

Kelly, Martha Hall *The Golden Doves* - Two former female spies, bound together by their past, risk everything to hunt down an infamous Nazi doctor in the aftermath of World War II.

Kepnes, Caroline *For You and Only You* -mystery- (Book 4 in the Joe Goldberg Series) Joe Goldberg heads to the hallowed halls of Harvard, where he earns a coveted place in a writing fellowship . . . and leaves crimson in his wake.

Keyes, J. Gregory *The Basilisk Throne* -fantasy - Rapid-paced high fantasy with all-out combat on the high seas, and a canny young woman who faces the hidden threats of an imperial court. Yet the key to defeating a sorcerous enemy may lie with a wild rogue and the slave of a maniac.

Klune, T. J. *In the Lives of Puppets* -fantasy - In a strange little home built into the branches of a grove of trees, live three robots—fatherly inventor android Giovanni Lawson, a pleasantly sadistic nurse machine, and a small vacuum desperate for love and attention. Victor Lawson, a human, lives there too. They're a family, hidden and safe.

Leather, Stephen *Still Standing* – (Book 3 in the Matt Standing Series) Matt investigates the suicide of an SAS soldier in Thailand whose twin brother knows it wasn't suicide.

Mackintosh, Sophie *Cursed Bread* - A darkly gleaming tale of a town gripped by hysteria, envy like poison in the blood, and desire that burns and consumes.

Makine, Andrei *My Armenian Friend* - A heart-wrenching novel that is at once an indelible portrait of friendship, a coming-of-age tale, and a dive into the memory of the Armenian genocide by the Ottoman Empire.

Marston, Edward *Death at the Terminus* – mystery – (Book 21 in the Railway Detective Series) A suspicious explosion...is it murder or an accident? It is up to Colbeck and Leeming to find out.

McCall Smith, Alexander *The Enigma of Garlic* –(Book 16 in the 44 Scotland Street Series) Come and discover The Enigma of Garlic, and join the delightful denizens of Edinburgh's most famous address.

Meier, Leslie *Mother of the Bride Murder* – cozy mystery – (Book 29 in the Lucy Stone Series) A surprise wedding in France sets the table in the latest book.

Mensah, Elvin James *Small Joys* - An epic novel about ordinary lives that introduces the world to an unforgettable cast of characters and a major new literary talent.

Miranda, Megan *The Only Survivors* -mystery- A group of former classmates reunite to mark the tenth anniversary of a tragic accident—only to have one of the survivors disappear, casting fear and suspicion on the original tragedy.

Moore, Susanna *The Lost Wife* - Drawn partly from a true story, a searing, totally immersive novel about a devastating Native American revolt, and a woman caught in the middle of the conflict.

Morton, Kate *Homecoming* -mystery- A sweeping novel that begins with a shocking crime, the effects of which echo across continents and generations.

Murray, Victoria Christopher *Pride* – (Book 5 in the Seven Deadly Sins Series) The story of an unputdownable novel following an entrepreneur who is determined to get everything she wants, no matter who she has to take it from.

Novak, Brenda *The Seaside Library* – romance- There are secrets that bring friends together, and others that drive them apart. Over the course of one eventful summer, Ariana, Ivy and Cam will learn the truth about their pasts, their futures and the ties that still bind them as closely as the pages of a book.

Palmer, Diana *The Loner* -romance- (Book 54 In the Long, Tall Texans series) Has globetrotting Tanner found forever in innocent Stasia Bolton from the ranch next door?

Parker, T. Jefferson *The Rescue* – mystery – Bettina gets more than she expected when she adopts an adorable dog being treated for a gunshot wound at a shelter – like the fact that he is a former DEA drug-sniffing dog.

Sandford, John *Dark Angel* -mystery – (Book 2 in the Letty Davenport Series) Letty Davenport, the tough-as-nails adopted daughter of Lucas Davenport, takes on an undercover assignment that brings her across the country and into the crosshairs of a dangerous group of hackers.

Thomas, Will *Heart of the Nile* -mystery – (Book 14 in the Barker and Llewelyn Series) London, 1893. Deadly doings are afoot in the British Museum and private enquiry agents Cyrus Barker and Thomas Llewelyn must unravel a mystery involving a mummy, a giant ruby and a murder.

Ward, J. R. *Lassiter* -romance – (Book 21 in the Black Dagger Brotherhood Series) A fallen angel finds love with a mysterious female—who could be his destiny...or the embodiment of his utter destruction.

Williams, Jen *Games for Dead Girls* -fantasy - A ritualistic game turns deadly for two young girls, but it will be years before they must face the true horrors of their past.

Wiseman, Beth *Hopefully Ever After* – (Book 3 in the Amish Bookstore Series) Two young people must find the courage to defy expectations and become who they're meant to be.

Adams, Sarah *Practice Makes Perfect* – romance- When the owner of the local flower shop in Rome, Kentucky, makes a questionable agreement with a tattooed bad boy, a delightful friends-to-lovers romance begins to bloom.

Adjmi, Corie *The Marriage Box* - Casey Cohen, a Middle Eastern Jew, is a sixteen-year-old in New Orleans in the 1970s when she starts hanging out with the wrong crowd. Agbaje-Williams, Ore *The Three of Us* - Long-standing tensions between a husband, his wife, and her best friend finally come to a breaking point in this sharp domestic comedy of manners.

Baker, Jo *The Midnight News* -mystery - A gripping novel of one young woman's unraveling during the Blitz—a story of WWII intrigue, love, and danger.

Barclay, Linwood *The Lie Maker* -mystery- A man desperately tries to track down his father—who was taken into witness protection years ago—before his enemies can get to him.

Barker, Joanna *A Heart Worth Stealing* – romance – When Genevieve's father's pocket watch is stolen, she calls in thief-taker Jack Travers to help her out, but little did they know the watch was just a small part of the plot against her.

Bentley, Don *Tom Clancy Flash Point* – (A book in the Jack Ryan, Jr. Series) Jack Ryan, Jr., uncovers a secret that may threaten the United States and its president, Jack Ryan, Sr.

Carr, Jack *Only the Dead* – (Book 6 in the James Reece Series) James Reece is on a deadly mission that is generations in the making. But for a man on the warpath, odds are not important in this intoxicating and timely thriller.

Cline, Emma *The Guest* – mystery- Through a misstep at a dinner party, Alex is sent home by the older man she is staying with, but somehow she manages to stay on the island trailing destruction in her wake.

Cronin, Justin *The Ferryman* – horror- A riveting standalone novel about a group of survivors on a hidden island utopia—where the truth isn't what it seems.

Feehan, Christine *Ghostly Game* -romance- (Book 19 in the GhostWalker Series) Can Gideon “Eagle” Carpenter persuade Laurel “Rory” Chappel to take a chance on him?

Ferguson, Melissa *Famous for a Living* -romance – Can fallen superstar influencer Cat Cranwell fall for a ruggedly handsome park ranger who hates anything remotely connected to social media, quite possibly her included?

Fortune, Carley *Meet Me at the Lake* -romance- A random connection sends two strangers on a daylong adventure where they make a promise one keeps and the other breaks, with life-changing effects.

Gagnon, Michelle *Killing Me* - Amber Jamison cannot believe she’s about to become the latest victim of a serial killer—she’s savvy and street smart, so when she gets pushed into, of all things, a white windowless van, she's more angry than afraid. Hill, Donna *I Am Ayah - the Way Home* - History and the present collide in this fascinating and poignant new novel.

Hostin, Sunny *Summer on Sag Harbor* –(Book 2 in the summer Beach Series) When Olivia Jones comes to the hidden African American enclave in Sag Harbor she learns more about who she really is, and she redefined the meaning of joy, love, friendship, society, culture, and family – and restores her faith in herself.

Keane, Mary Beth *The Half Moon* – An exploration of a marriage in crisis, of what it means to make a life with another person, and of what it means to be a family.

Koomson, Dorothy *My Other Husband* -mystery- When Cleo Forsum decides to walk away from her life, people she knows start getting hurt, and it is clear someone is trying to frame her for murder.

Kuang, R.F. *Yellowface* - What's the harm in a pseudonym? Bestselling sensation Juniper Song is not who she says she is, she didn't write the book she claims she wrote, and she is most certainly not Asian American.

Lauren, Christina *The True Love Experiment* -romance - Sparks fly when a romance novelist and a documentary filmmaker join forces to craft the perfect Hollywood love story and take both of their careers to the next level—but only if they can keep the chemistry between them from taking the whole thing off script.

Lustbader, Eric Van *The Quantum Solution* – (Book 4 in the Evan Ryder Series) Evan finds herself in a battle arena whose dangers, while less obvious, are greater than anything the world has seen before – the present and future war of weaponized quantum technology.

Maden, Mike *Clive Cussler's Untitled Oregon 17* – (Book 17 in the Oregon Files) Juan Cabrillo and the crew of the Oregon are back.

McGill, C.E. *Our Hideous Progeny* – horror- A brilliant revisiting of Mary Shelley's classic *Frankenstein* that unfolds with a fresh, provocative, queer twist.

McKnight, Rhonda *The Thing About Home* -When her marriage implodes, Casey runs from NYC to South Carolina's low country hoping to find long lost family.

McLean, Michelle *Four Weddings and a Duke*- romance - The Duke trope is turned on its head with a witty, laugh-out-loud Regency perfect for fans of Eloisa James and Sarah MacLean.

Monroe, Katrina *Graveyard of Lost Children* -horror- Olivia was almost murdered at 4 months old and her mother became obsessed with the idea that Olivia was a changeling. Now Olivia is pregnant, and history seems to be repeating.

Nesbo, Jo *Killing Moon*- mystery- (Book 13 in the Harry Hole Series) The hunt is on, and the police are running out of time. They are facing a killer unlike any other and to catch him will push Harry to the limit – and for Harry things just got personal.

O'Keefe, Megan E. *The Blighted Stars* – science fiction –(Book One in the Devoured World Series) When a spy is stranded on a dead planet with her mortal enemy, she must first figure out how to survive before she can uncover the conspiracy that landed them there.

Paetro, Maxine and James Patterson *23<sup>rd</sup> Midnight* -mystery- (book 23 in the women's Murder Club Series) An attention-seeking copycat is recreating murders by a famous killer from the Women's Murder Club's past with devastating new twists.

Quick, Amanda *The Bride Wore White* -romance- (Book 7 in the Burning Cove, CA Series) A woman wakes up in a honeymoon suite dressed in a wedding gown, next to the groom. Problem is, she's not the bride and he's been murdered.

Roberts, Nora *Identity* -mystery- A terrifying new thriller about one man's ice-cold malice, and one woman's fight to reclaim her life.

Rowley, Steven *The Celebrants* - A big chill for our times, celebrating decades-long friendships and promises—especially to ourselves.



Saint, Jennifer *Atalanta* - A reimagining of the myth of Atalanta, a fierce huntress raised by bears and the only woman in the world's most famous band of heroes, the Argonauts.

Senécal, Patrick *Silent Move* - When a young man is trapped in a house by a madman, he's forced to play according to his captor's rules or die trying.

Starnone, Domenico *The House on Via Gemito* – Federi, a railway clerk, is convinced he is possessed of great artistic talent and that if it weren't for his family that he has to feed he would be a world famous painter.

Steel, Danielle *The Wedding Planner* - A wildly successful, unmarried wedding planner leads her clients to happily ever after.

Verghese, Abraham *The Covenant of Water* - Spanning the years 1900 to 1977, *The Covenant of Water* follows a family in southern India that suffers a peculiar affliction: in every generation, at least one person dies by drowning - and in Kerala, water is everywhere.
