Ward, Amanda Eyre *Lovers and Liars* -Three wildly different sisters reunite for a destination wedding at an English castle.

Ware, Ruth One Perfect Couple -mystery -This high-tension and ingenious thriller follows five couples trapped on a storm-swept island as a killer stalk among them.

Weaver, Ashley Locked in Pursuit – mystery –(Book 4 in the Electra McDonnell Series) Safecracker Electra McDonnell is fighting Nazis at every turn as World War II looms over London.

Weir, Alison *The Passionate Tudor* – (Book 3 in the Tudor Rose Series) The dramatic and poignant life of King Henry VIII's daughter, infamously known as Bloody Mary, who ruled England for five violent years.
