Balogh, Mary *Always Remember* -romance- (Book 3 in the Ravenswood Series) Lady Jennifer and Ben Ellis know that a match between them is out of the question. Yet, their hearts yearn for the impossible.

Denker, Jayne *Hedging Your Bets* -romance- Opposites attract in this enemies-to-lovers romantic comedy of feuding neighbors and dueling hearts.

Doka, Jeff *The Distributor* -science fiction- In a world without rain, the desert sands are controlled by the only group with the technology and infrastructure to give water to the thirsty: The Distributor.

Elston, Ashley *First Lie Wins* -mystery - Evie Porter has everything a nice, Southern girl could want: a perfect boyfriend, a house, a garden, and friends. The only catch: Evie Porter doesn't exist.

Enrique, Alvaro *You Dreamed of Empires* - One morning in 1519, conquistador Hernán Cortés entered the city of Tenochtitlan, later that day, he would meet the emperor Moctezuma.

Fawcett, Heather *Emily Wilde's Map of the Otherlands* -fantasy – (Book 2 in the Emily Wilde Series)  
When faeries appear at her university, professor Emily Wilde must uncover their secrets.

Ferraro, Nicolas *My Favorite Scar* -mystery - A teenage girl and her gangster father embark on a road trip toward revenge.

Ford, Olivia *Mrs. Quinn's Rise to Fame* – After 59 years of marriage, Jenny does something for herself and enters a TV show, but this new stress starts to unearth memories buried decades ago.

Frankel, Laurie *Family Family* – Actress India Allwood is doing a movie about adoption, a topic she knows all too well. She's an adoptive mom who gave up a child to adoption as a teen, who wants to meet her.

Fredericks, Mariah *The Wharton Plot* – mystery- It is 1911, and Edith Wharton is bone tired of Manhattan, but when David Graham Phillips is shot to death she is curious to discover why?

Goldberg, Lee *Dream Town* – mystery – (Book 5 in the Eve Ronin Series) A gated dream town for the megarich becomes a murderous nightmare.

Golden, Christopher *The House of Last Resort* -horror- Little did Tommy and Kate Puglisi know that buying their abandoned home in Italy for a single Euro would lead them to the house of last resort.

Goodwin, Daisy *Diva* – Maria Callas and Ari Onassis had one of the greatest breakups of all time, and that is when she finally found her true voice.

Grippando, James *Goodbye Girl* – (Book 18 in the Jack Swyteck Series) A contentious intellectual piracy case leads to an unsolved murder, and Jack Swyteck's client—a pop music icon—is the accused killer.

Grumley, Michael C. *Deep Freeze* -science fiction- (Book 1 in the Revival Series) John Reiff thought he was dead, so why are doctors claiming everything will be normal as he struggles to move, see, and breathe. He has a strange feeling there is something they aren't telling him.

Hawkins, Rachel *The Heiress* -mystery- The death of a notorious heiress leaves an inescapable legacy for her adopted son and an inheritance that entails far more than what was written in the will.

Heckenlively, Kent *The King of Italy* – A sweeping family saga beginning when Vincenzo Nicosia watches his father go to jail for beating a man to death, and the man he blames is the illegitimate son of King Victor Immanuel II, the unifier of Italy in the 1870s.

Khan, Shubnum *The Djinn Waits a Hundred Years* – A gorgeously atmospheric novel about a ruined mansion by the sea, the djinn that haunts it, and a curious girl who unearths the tragedy that happened there a hundred years ago.

Koontz, Dean R. *The Bad Weather Friend* -mystery- When Benny Catspaw receives an inheritance from an uncle he never met, he did not expect a 7’ tall menacing friend named Spike to solve all his problems.

Krentz, Jayne Ann *The Night Island* -romance- (Book 2 in the Lost Night Files Series) The disappearance of a mysterious informant leads two people desperate for answers to an island of deadly deception.

Kumar, Naina *Say You’ll Be Mine* -romance- A teacher with big dreams joins forces with a no-nonsense engineer to survive an ex’s wedding and escape matchmaking pressure from their Indian families.

Lee, Rosey *The Gardens of Edin* - When the bonds in their family begin to fray, four Black women fight to preserve their legacy, heal their wounds, and move forward together.

Leteri, Christy *The Book of Fire*-Once there lived a family whose life goes up in flames in a single day when one man starts a fire out of greed and indifference. But this family survives, and hope grows.

Linden, Rachel *Recipe for a Charmed Life* -romance- Can a promising young chef, an annoying but handsome oyster farmer, and a mysterious family legacy create a true recipe for a charmed life?

Lister, Sheryl *No Reservations* – romance- Four friends, three struggling relationships, and one final wish: find your happiness.

Maas, Sarah J. *House of Flame and Shadow* -romance- (Book 3 in the Crescent City Series) Bryce and Hunt's world is brought to the brink of collapse with its future resting on their shoulders.

MacKin, Jeanne *Picasso's Lovers* - A vivid reimagination of the women drawn into Pablo Picasso's charismatic orbit.

Marshall, Kate Alice -mystery- A novel about three sisters, two murders, and too many secrets to count.

Matar, Hisham *My Friends* - A luminous novel of friendship, family, and the unthinkable realities of exile.

Matthews, Mimi *The Lily of Ludgate Hill* -romance- (Book 3 in the Belles of London Series) Fortune favors the bold, but is a confirmed spinster daring enough to loosen the reins and accept a favor from the wicked gentleman who haunts her dreams?

McCauley, Stephen *You Only Call When You're in Trouble* – Just when Tom finally decides it is time to put himself first, his family drags him back in to their familiar chaos.

McRady, Rachel *Sun Seekers* – When 6-year-old Gracie Lynn goes on the run with her Grandpa John hoping to save him from the “worm” that is eating his brain, it becomes a nightmare for her parents as they struggle to find them.

Michaelides, Alex *The Fury* -mystery- “There were seven of us in all, trapped on the island. One of us was a murderer.”

Miller, Suzie *Prima Facie* – When barrister Tessa Ensler is raped by a co-worker, she struggles to find the strength to bring him to justice in the face of the barriers and opposition within that same system.

Min, Katherine *The Fetishist* - In this hilarious poignant novel, a grieving daughter's revenge on the man who caused her mother's death sets off a series of unexpected reckonings.

Modesitt Jr, L.E. *From the Forest* -fantasy- (Book 23 in the Saga of Recluce Series) Alayiakal has to climb the ranks of Cyador's Mirror Lancers, fighting against unforeseen weapons and ancient technology.

Moorman, Jennifer *The Magic All Around* - The Russell family members all have gifts that they will need to lead them to complete a series of seemingly absurd tasks in order to claim their inheritance.

Murphy, Catie *Death by Irish Whiskey*-cozy mystery- (Book 5 in the Dublin Driver Series) The competition for best whiskey turns out to be a bad blend when a contestant dies at a whiskey tasting.

Naylor, Ray *The Tusks of Extinction* -science fiction- Dr. Damira Khismatullina was murdered defending the world's last elephants, and now her consciousness is downloaded into the mind of a mammoth.

Parekh, Nishita *The Night of the Storm*-cozy mystery- A multigenerational Indian-American family marooned in a house with a murderer during Hurricane Harvey.

Patterson, James and Brian Sitts *Holmes, Marple and Poe* -mystery- In New York City, three intriguing, smart, and stylish private investigators open Holmes, Marple & Poe Investigations.

Pease, Amy *Northwoods* -mystery - The dark underbelly of an idyllic Midwestern resort town is revealed in the aftermath of a murder with ties to America's opioid epidemic.

Penrose, Andrea *The Diamond of London* -historical- Based on the real life of Lady Hester Stanhope, a British aristocrat, antiquarian, and adventurer.

Perry, Thomas *Hero* -mystery- A private security agent finds that being branded as the City of Angels' latest hero could also make her its next victim.

Perry, Tyler and Echo Brown *A Jazzman's Blues* -historical- A moving and unforgettable tale of love and family secrets set in Georgia in the 1940s.

Plantinga, Adam *The Ascent* -mystery- When a high security prison fails, a down-on-his-luck cop and the governor's daughter are going to have to team up if they're going to escape.

Quinn, Cate *The Clinic* -mystery- When her sister dies mysteriously in a rehab clinic, Meg decides the best way to find the truth is to check in herself, but finding the truth is more difficult than she imagined.

Robb, J. D. *Random in Death* – (Book 58 in the In Death Series) A small and easily concealed weapon wreaks havoc, and the killer is just a face in the crowd.

Robert, Katee *Midnight Ruin* -romance- (Book 6 in the Dark Olympus Series) A scorchingly hot modern retelling of Eurydice, Orpheus, and Charon.

Ruiz, Sarah Grunder *Last Call at the Local* - romance- Opposites attract when a free-spirited American singer-songwriter with ADHD teams up with a charming Irishman to revitalize his family's pub.

Ryan, Anastasia *Not Bad for a Girl* – romance- From hilariously awkward lunch breaks to cringe-worthy Zoom calls, this workplace comedy of errors is sure to put a smile on your face.

Santlofer, Jonathan *The Lost Van Gogh* – mystery- When a missing Van Gogh is found and later disappears, a dangerous and deadly search results that exposes secrets from a dark era.

Schultz, Emily *Sleeping with Friends* -mystery- (Book 1 in the Friends and Enemies Series) A twisted story about a woman's attempted murder, her lost memories, and the old friends who try to put her back together—or finish her off for good.

Shalvis, Jill *The Bright Spot* -romance- (Book 5 in the Sunrise Cove Series) A heartwarming story about the choices we make and the love we let into our lives.

Shawl, Nisi *Kinning* – science fiction- (Book 2 in the Everfair Series) A continuation into the stunning alternate history where airships soar through the sky, and colonies claim their freedom.

Steel, Danielle *Upside Down* - A powerful story of unconventional romance, bold choices and second chances.

Stevenson, Benjamin *Everyone on This Train Is a Suspect* -mystery- Ernest Cunningham returns in a deliciously witty locked room (train) mystery.

Sullivan, Sophie *Love, Naturally* -romance- A charming opposites-attract romance for anyone who ever stepped outside their comfort zone and found that all the best things can happen when you take a chance.

Swierczynski, Duane *California Bear* -mystery- Four unlikely vigilantes whose decision to take justice into their own hands pits them against the villain behind California's coldest case.

Tate, ReShonda *The Queen of Sugar Hill* -historical- A fascinating fictional portrait of Hattie McDaniel, one of Hollywood's most prolific but woefully underappreciated stars.

Taylor, Brad *Dead Man's Hand* – (Book 18 in the Pike Logan Series) Pike Logan investigates a threat to a key European ally and discovers a secret that could lead to world annihilation.

Tremel, Joyce *Deadly to the Core* -mystery- (A Book in the Cider House Series) When Kate Mulligan inherits her uncle's fruit orchard, she sees that apples aren't the only thing that can have rotten cores.

Vardiashvili, Leo *Hard by a Great Forest* - A powerful novel about the trauma of war, and the indomitable spirit of a people determined not only to survive but to remember those who did not.

Walsh, Jenni L. *Unsinkable*-historical- Violet's sinking on the Titanic was only the beginning, and no one can understand why she returns to sea, but she is trying simply to survive.

Weber, David and Chris Kennedy *To Challenge Heaven* -science fiction- (Book 3 in the Out of the Dark Series) In a universe teeming with predators, humanity needs friends. And fast.

Wibberley, Emily and Austin Siegemund-Broka *The Breakup Tour* -romance -A rising-star musician has a second chance at love with an old flame she remembers all too well.

Willingham, Stacy *Only If You're Lucky* -mystery - A sharp and twisty exploration of female friendship.

Lebbon, Tim *Among the Living* -horror- A terrifying novel set in a melting Arctic landscape. Something deadly has lain dormant for thousands of years, but now the permafrost is giving up its secret.

Lim, Roselle *Night for Day* – romance - Two people destined to be together, but to never see each other again, fight against the greatest odds.

Link, Kelly *The Book of Love* -fantasy- Three teenagers become pawns in a supernatural power struggle.

Livesey, Margot *The Road from Belhaven* - A novel about a young woman whose gift of second sight complicates her coming of age in late-19<sup>th</sup>-century Scotland.
